Sub: Approval of Middle Class Syllabus (I – VIII) to the above said school.

Dear Sir/Madam,

With reference to your application dated **30/06/2011** and subsequent correspondence with the school / inspection in this regard, I am directed to convey the grant for Provisional approval of the Competent Authority of the Board for **Middle Classes syllabus** for a period of **three years w.e.f. 01.04.2012 to 31.03.2015**.

The above sanction is subject to fulfillment of following conditions:-

1. “The School will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT for the middle classes.”
2. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State Govt./UT.
3. The school will follow CCE scheme vide Circular No. 39/20-09-2009 dated 20.09.2009 in the school.
4. The grant for approval of the middle classes is not extendable and does not in any way imply any obligation on the part of the Board to affiliate the Secondary Classes (IX-X).
5. The approval will also be subject to the condition that the school will make a fresh application for Provisional Affiliation of the Secondary Classes (IX-X) to the Board on line through CBSE website www.cbseaff.nic.in or www.cbse.nic.in in accordance with the rules and condition for Provisional Affiliation when classes VIII has been started.
6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under :-

(a)	1.0 acre	1250	02 in each class
(b)	1.5 acre	1875	03 in each class
(c)	2.0 acre	2500	04 in each class

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.

- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

(i)	Secondary School	2000 sq. mtrs	600 upto Class X
(ii)	Sr. Secondary School with two streams	3000 sq. mtrs	900 upto Class XII

7. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff as per qualification laid down in the rules.
8. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by the State Government concerned.
9. Service conditions, pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect be sent to C.B.S.E.
10. The school and its records shall be opened for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorised representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
11. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the facilities provided.

12. The admission to the school shall be opened to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
13. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
14. The school will abide itself by the rules and conditions for affiliation as given in the Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
15. The school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'persons with disabilities act-1995'.
16. The school should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers or computer student ratio of 1:20 and proper software alongwith facility of Broad Band Connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider.
17. **The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school as per rules. A copy each of the Statements of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year.**
18. The affiliation Code Number allotted to your school is **1130352**. This may please be noted and quoted for any correspondence with the Board.
19. Reserve Fund be maintained in the joint name of the Secretary, CBSE and the School Authorities in accordance with the enrolment in the school from time to time.
20. Renewal of Registration of Society if any, be ensured.
21. School will provide physical facilities as per norms of the Board. The facilities reported at the time of last inspection are as given under:-

23. Special conditions to be complied within three months:-

- a) The school is required to submit a Certificate of land in the format given at Appendix-VI of Affiliation Bye-Laws. The Affiliation Bye-Laws and land certificate format are available at CBSE website www.cbseaff.nic.in.
- b) The school is required to submit an affidavit duly sworn in before a First Class Magistrate by the President or Secretary of the society/Trust running the school stating that the "Society is of Non-Proprietary Character" in nature.
- c) The school is required to provide a copy of acquittance roll for the last 03 months and documents evidence that the salaries are being paid as per VIth pay commission/State Govt. norms and also through bank by single banker cheque.
- d) Number of books in the school library is less than 1500. The school is required to procure more books relevant to the academic level of students in the library and keep at least 05 books per student in the library subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
- e) The school is required to re-constitute the SMC as per the provisions of Affiliation Bye-laws of the Board and ensure that no blood relation is there in the S.M.C.
- f) The school is required to send teachers for CCE, In-service, refresher/re-orientation programme to update their knowledge and teaching skills.
- g) The school is required to submit Completion Certificate of under construction work/building.
- h) The school is required to appoint trained and qualified librarian and submit documentary proof.
